BOARD MEMBER RESPONSIBILITIES

1. Serves a minimum of one (1) three-year term on the Board. Eligible to serve an additional three-year term if re-elected.
2. Attends all Tier 1 fundraising events (maximum of 3/year), volunteers for at least 1 Tier 2 event, and attends 84% (2 misses) of monthly board meetings. The Full Board of Directors meets the 3rd Tuesday of every month from 7:00 p.m. to 8:30 p.m.
3. Makes a serious commitment to participate actively in committee work when appropriate.
4. Stays informed about committee matters, is prepared for meetings, and reviews and comments on minutes and reports.
5. Builds a collegial working relationship with other committee & Board members that contributes to consensus.
6. Participates in the Organization's annual evaluation and planning efforts.
7. Participates in the development & advancement of the strategic plan of Micah 6:8 Ministries.
